





A special invitation to all those who took the Green Fleet Bridge lessons last year and any other


members who are bridge players who would like to join us this year.



NJ Boater's Safety Course 6pm to 9:30pm | June 17th & 19th (Mon/Wed)

Join us on **June 17th and 19th from 6 to 9:30 pm*** in the Commodore's Lounge as Captain Lew Donovan brings his vast knowledge of navigating the challenging South Jersey waterways to lead the NJ boater's safety course in two sessions.** Whether you're an experienced boater or a beginner embarking on your first journey, this course serves as your guide to safe and responsible boating in New Jersey's coastal areas.

Upon successful completion of the 8-hour course, (including a 60-question exam), you will receive your New Jersey Boating Safety Certificate.*** This certificate must be carried when operating any powerboat or PWC in New Jersey. The course is open to anyone 13 and up.

* You must attend both sessions

** One hour of home study is required (two 3.5 hour sessions and 1 hour of study=8 hours) *** Mandatory for anyone operating a power vessel (e.g., motorboats, Jet Skis/PWCs) in NJ

A Message from the fleet surgeom

Measles

2024 has already been a significant year already for Measles outbreaks in the United States. So far in 2024, there have been 121 cases of measles reported with seven different outbreaks. For a comparison, in the entire year of 2023 there were 58 cases. One of these outbreaks occurred in Philadelphia in December 2023 to January 2024.

What is Measles and why the concern? Measles is a highly contagious viral illness. Symptoms include high fever, the 3 C's: cough, coryza (runny nose and congestion) and conjunctivitis (red eyes), and rash. The classic rash starts on the head and spreads down to the feet. For those who are unvaccinated and exposed, 9 out of 10 will develop the disease. Spread is both from droplets from coughing and sneezing but it is also airborne. It is one of the most contagious viruses in the world.

Prior to the Measles vaccine becoming available in 1963, there were an average of 549,000 reported cases of measles per year and 495 deaths in the United States. However, it is likely that there were about 3-4 million cases in the United States yearly, but most were not reported. Of the reported cases prior to the vaccine becoming available, 48,000 people were hospitalized and 1,000 people became disabled from acute encephalitis every year.

Complications of measles occur most commonly in infants and children under age 5, adults over 20 years of age, pregnant women, and people with compromised immune systems. Complications include ear infections, diarrhea, pneumonia, encephalitis, and death. Encephalitis which is an inflammation of the brain occurs in 1 of every 1000 cases. It can lead to permanent brain damage. Death occurs in 1 to 3 of every 1000 cases. Rare complications such as Subacute Sclerosing Panencephalitis (SSPE) can occur 7 to 11 years after measles at a rate or 4 to 11 per 100,000 measles cases. It is a progressive, degenerative neurological disease. There is no cure for this.

There is no treatment for measles so the best weapon we have is prevention with vaccines. Measles vaccines are recommended for all children from the age of 12 months, with a second dose recommended at least 28 days after the first but usually done at age 4 to 6. For infants 6 months to 12 months who are traveling internationally, a dose is recommended prior to travel. This dose does not count as part of the regular vaccine schedule so two more doses are recommended.
